National Youth Day of India – 12 January



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India celebrates National Youth Day on 12 January every year. The day commemorates the birthday of Swami Vivekananda, one of India's greatest spiritual and social leaders.

- The decision to celebrate National Youth Day was taken in 1984 by the Government of India.
- During the declaration of day, the Government of India quoted that “the philosophy of Swami and the ideals for which he lived and worked could be a great source of inspiration for the Indian Youth”.
- The day is very important especially today because 50% of India's population is under the age of 25.

The theme for National Youth Day 2022 is “It's all in the mind,” a key teaching of Swami Vivekananda. He was known for preaching religious tolerance and combining Indian spirituality with western material progress. As per his belief, the two supplemented and complemented each other perfectly.

A key event for January 12 is the National Youth Festival where people from all across the country gather and participate in cultural and educational activities to promote unity and innovation among them. This year, the festival will take place over a period of 5 days, Jan 12 to 16 and will be conducted in four phases including a youth summit, indigenous games awareness, yoga and cultural celebrations.

PM Modi will be inaugurating a five-day festival for 25th National Youth Day through video conferencing. He will be addressing the gathering on the occasion of Swami Vivekananda's birth anniversary.
